Nevada Nearly Doubles GESPC Investment in One Year

May, 2016: The Nevada ESC Chapter reports it has nearly doubled its total investment dollars in GESPC in the past year – going from \$100 million to \$183,978,010. There are several projects currently in the audit phase, and Nevada expects to make monetary awards to two agencies under its PCAAP (Performance Contract Audit Assistance Program), which reimburses an agency for their IGA once they sign a contract to proceed with construction.
